## CHANGES IN THE I LITRE M.G.

A slightly-revised version of the popular M.G. 11-litre saloon, series "YA," to be known as the series "YB," is announced by the Nuffield Organisation. Detail improvements which have been carried out include a hypoid rear axle, similar to that used in the "TD" M.G., to give quieter riding. Bigger shock-absorbers all round are a feature of the suspension, and an anti-roll bar is fitted at the front end. Braking is improved, and an 8-in. clutch is used instead of the 71 in. size of the series "YA."

External differences are few. Both front and rear bumpers now have over-riders, and the valance on the rear wings has been slightly deepened.
