Final Instructions to Competitors

Welcome to the Autumn Naviscat

The question sheets will be given out at 11.00 a.m. You can commence plotting the locations as soon as you receive the question sheets. They give six figure map references for 45 locations, and a clue or question for each. The locations may be visited in any order.

The number of points awarded for each clue varies according to the difficulty of the question and location. A single point is given for straightforward answers, which can often be seen from the car (e.g. a telephone number on a signboard). More difficult clues, requiring more of a search, and perhaps a little brain power, attract two points, while threes are even more challenging - often difficult to find, and usually hard to figure out. The locations have been chosen so that there are places to park off the road near to the clues. The questions with * alongside indicate a "Drive-by" where the answers can be seen from the car without stopping, although you may have to proceed quite slowly.

The team with the highest score wins, **but only the best 30 answers given will be marked.** In the event of a tie, the winner will be the competitor with the earliest finish time. **You should hand your sheets in at the finish by 2.30 p.m. - lateness will incur penalty points - the loss of 1 point per minute.**

Cars with 3 people over 10 years old will have their points reduced by 10%, while cars with 4 people will have their points reduced by 15%.

The team to arrange next year's Naviscat will be taken from the overall top four MGCC finishers (the names put in a pre-sealed envelope, to be opened and the name drawn out at the prize giving). Rosettes will be given out at the prize giving, but the MG Car Club awards will be given out at the Annual General Meeting, or other selected Centre event..

As usual, please drive carefully, park safely, and watch out for pedestrians, cyclists, and horses, all of which are likely to be out on a Sunday. Remember this is not a speed event, and make sure you leave yourselves plenty of time to reach the finish before xxxx p.m.

The finish is at the Three Horseshoes pub in Thursley, Surrey. Map Ref.903 397

We are taking lunch orders at the start to help reduce the waiting time at the pub. The lunch menu will be available signing on, so you can make your selection before you start the Naviscat.

Good luck, have fun, and we'll see you at the finish.
