MENDIP CAR TRIAL 2008 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. The MGCC (SW) will organise a 'Clubsport' Car Trial on <u>Sunday 24th August 2008</u> at Pagans Hill Farm, Chew Stoke, Bristol, **Map Ref 172/558628**, courtesy of **Tony and Sally Baker**.
- 2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the international Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. MSA Permit No (to be advised) has been issued.
- 4. The event is open to fully elected members of the following:
 - a) MG Car Club
 - b) Bristol Motor Club
 - c) Bristol Pegasus Motor Club
 - d) The Classic and Historic Motor Club
 - e) Woolbridge Motor Club
- 5. All competitors and drivers **MUST PRODUCE**:
 - 1. A valid club membership card. (a competition licence is **NOT REQUIRED** for this event).
 - A valid MOT Certificate for the competing vehicle.
 Failure to produce either of the above WILL RESULT IN THE ENTRY BEING REJECTED.
- 6. The event is a round of the MGCC (SW) Drivers Championship.
- 7. The programme of the meeting will be :

Scrutineering starts at 9.30am.

Drivers briefing 10.25am.

First car starts 10.30am.

Any competitor not signed on by 10.30am may be excluded.

- 8. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 4 tests on private land. There will be a minimum of 3 attempts at each test. (The number of attempts at each test to count may be increased from the minimum number subject to conditions on the day, details to be given at the drivers briefing by the Clerk of Course). Tests will be laid out within walking distance of the signing-on area, and competitors may walk the course prior to commencement. The entry will be split into groups starting at different tests, details to be given at the drivers briefing.
- 9. The event will consist of classes as follows:

Class 1: 2WD Production Cars carrying no ballast.

Two Wheel Drive Production Cars. First registered on or after Jan 1st 1996, carrying no ballast, no modifications and driven to the venue. The original carburettors, or fuel injection system including the throttle body and plenum chamber, including the air filter system must be retained. It is permitted to replace the air filter element within the original housing.

It is permitted to fit a sump guard weighing not more than 10 kg.

This class may be sub-divided into Front and Rear wheel drive classes subject to min 3 of each drive.

Class 2: FWD Production Cars.

Front Wheel Drive Production Cars not eligible for Class 1.

Class 3: RWD Production Cars.

Rear Wheel Drive Production Cars not eligible for Class 1.

Transmission: In Classes 1-3 only gear and axle ratios as stated in the Official manufacturers handbook

for the model and year of manufacture can be used.

Wheels / Tyres: In Classes 1-3 use only wheels of standard diameter or a max + or - 2in (50mm) that of

originally specified for that make and model of the vehicle, provided that they can be fitted

without altering the hubs or anything attached to them.

Class 4: Modified Production Cars and Kit Cars

This class covers:

- 1. Production Cars modified beyond Classes 1-3 and modified up to the limits specified in Reg 59 (classes 1-6)
- 2. Front-engined Kit cars to approved MSA specification.
- 3. Front engined Kit Cars modified beyond Car Trials Regulations and modified up to the limits specified in Reg 59 Class 7(c) (ACTC approved specification)

The above classes may be sub-divided or amalgamated subject to entries. Entries of vehicles with four wheel drive or of pick-up design will not be accepted.

NOTE

- 1 .All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations and must be equipped with an effective silencer.
- 2. ALL VEHICLES MUST CARRY A FIRE EXTINGUISHER to a level of safety specified in C(c)-56(a) Small, hand-operated min 1.75 litres type AFFF (Aqueous film forming foam)
- 3. During observed sections THE SEAT NEXT TO THE DRIVER MUST BE OCCUPIED. J 13
- 10. Awards will be presented at the MGCC SW Centre Annual Dinner on Saturday March 14th 2009 as follows:
 - 1. 1st in class subject to min 3 starters / 2nd min 6 starters / 3rd min 9 starters.
 - 2. The best MG Car Club member driving an MG, irrespective of class
 - 3. The best Bristol MC member irrespective of class subject to 4 BMC entries O/A.
 - 4. The best Bristol Pegasus MC member irrespective of class subject to 4 BPMC entries O/A.
 - 5. The best Classic and Historic MC member irrespective of class subject to 4 CHMC entries O/A
 - 6. The best Woolbridge MC member irrespective of class subject to 4 WMC entries O/A
 - 7. Best pre 1955 car.
 - 8. Best pre 1980 car
 - 9. Novice (as defined in C (a) 64)
 - 10. Ladies (subject to 3 entrants) Best performance irrespective of class

No competitor may win more than one award

- 11. The entry opens on publication of the S.R,s and finally closes at 9.30am on <u>Sunday 24th August 2008</u>. The entry fee in advance is £10. (£12 on the day). All entries must be made on the official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee.

Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected and numbers issued in order of postal receipt and on the day in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded if an entry is withdrawn and notice given in writing to the Secretary of the Meeting at least 24 hours before the event is due to start.

- 19. Marking and penalties will be as described in **J 51** where applicable.
- 20. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.
- 21. Entries will only be acknowledged if accompanied by a S.A.E.
