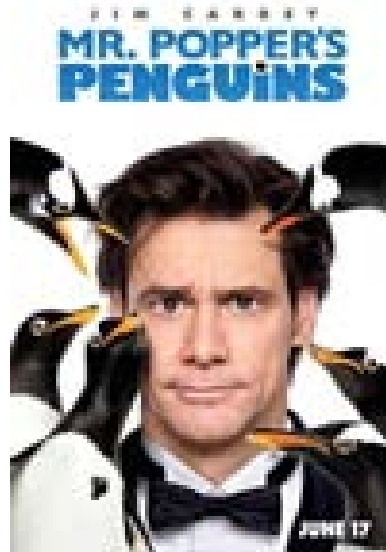
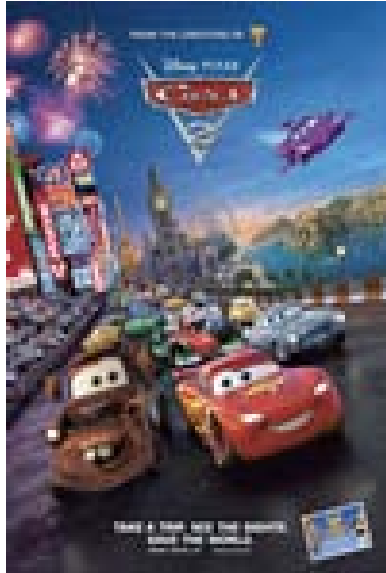
National Collector Car Appreciation Day

In recognition and celebration, the WDMGC is organizing a Night at the Drive-in Movies. The venue is The New US 23 Drive-In Theater at 5200 Fenton Road, Flint MI.

Playing on Screen 2 will be a Double Feature - *Cars 2* and *Mr. Popper's Penguins*



Also playing on Screen 1 is *Transformers: Dark of the Moon* and *Super 8* and on Screen 3 is *Bad Teacher* followed by *Green Lantern*

Gates open at 7:30, First Feature at 9:25, and Second Feature at 11:35
Cost is – Adult \$7, Student \$6, Child (4-12) \$5 and Child (3 & under) Free

To assure that we can park together, we need to arrive together when the gates open. We can try to hold some spots for later arrivals but there is no guarantee. You can meet us at the Drive-In at 7:30, located north of Hill Rd between US-23 and I-475. There is no Hill Rd or Fenton Rd exit from I-75.

Or, for a nice ride you can join us by 6:30 at the McDonald's at M-59 Highland Rd and Milford Rd, at 450 N Milford Rd, Highland, MI. We will leave no later than 6:45 to run north thru Holly and Fenton.

Either way you get there, you will likely want to take US-23 or I-475 / I-75 home after the movies.

Concessions are available at the Drive-In, including fresh grilled burgers, chicken tenders, fries, etc. Or pack a picnic dinner (no glass bottles, no bbq grills). Alcohol is discouraged but not prohibited, discretion is encouraged. The Drive-In survives on concessions so they appreciate your support.

Audio is heard from your car radio. Otherwise, bring a portable radio or rent one for \$3 from the Drive-In. If you don't want to sit in your car, bring lawn chairs to sit in front of your vehicle.

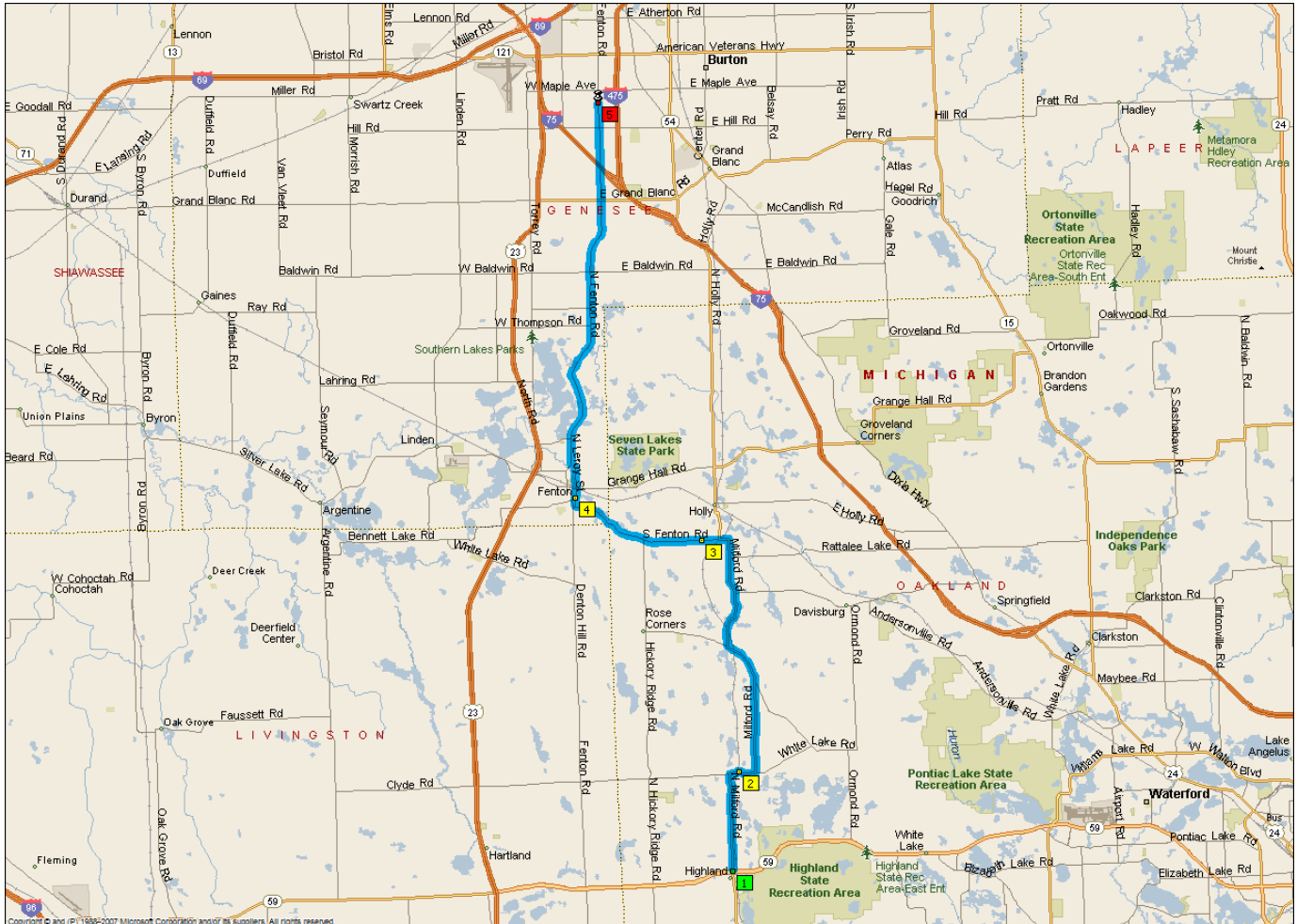

Drive-In Do's



- Lawn chairs are allowed directly in front of your vehicle, but not on either side next to it. You will be asked to move if the space is needed.
- The grassy area directly in front of the screen is a great spot for lawn chairs and blankets, and children are welcome to use this area, however, their safety and welfare is your responsibility.
- Keep an eye on your children. Children under the age of 16 must be under parental supervision at all times.
- Park RV's, High Vans, Big SUV's in the back rows.
- Please be courteous to the other patrons around you.
- **ABSOLUTELY DO** visit the concession stand. The US 23 Drive-In survives on the revenue generated from concessions. And we try harder than anyone else to provide the best value. Help us continue to serve you.

Drive-In Dont's



- Please don't damage the parking poles. Parking poles have been installed based on customer demand to create consistent parking. This also allows us to get more vehicles into the drive-in resulting in less turnaways.
- Sitting in the back of your pick-up is allowed, as long as you don't block the view of other patrons.
- No smoking in the Snack Bar.
- Laser Pointers are **FORBIDDEN !!** Use of a laser pointer will result in your expulsion from the theater for the remainder of the season.
- No glass bottles, No Grills or BBQ's.
- No bare feet.
- Please don't litter.
- Do not park on the grass.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is discouraged.
