2800 Tecumseh Road East, Windsor.

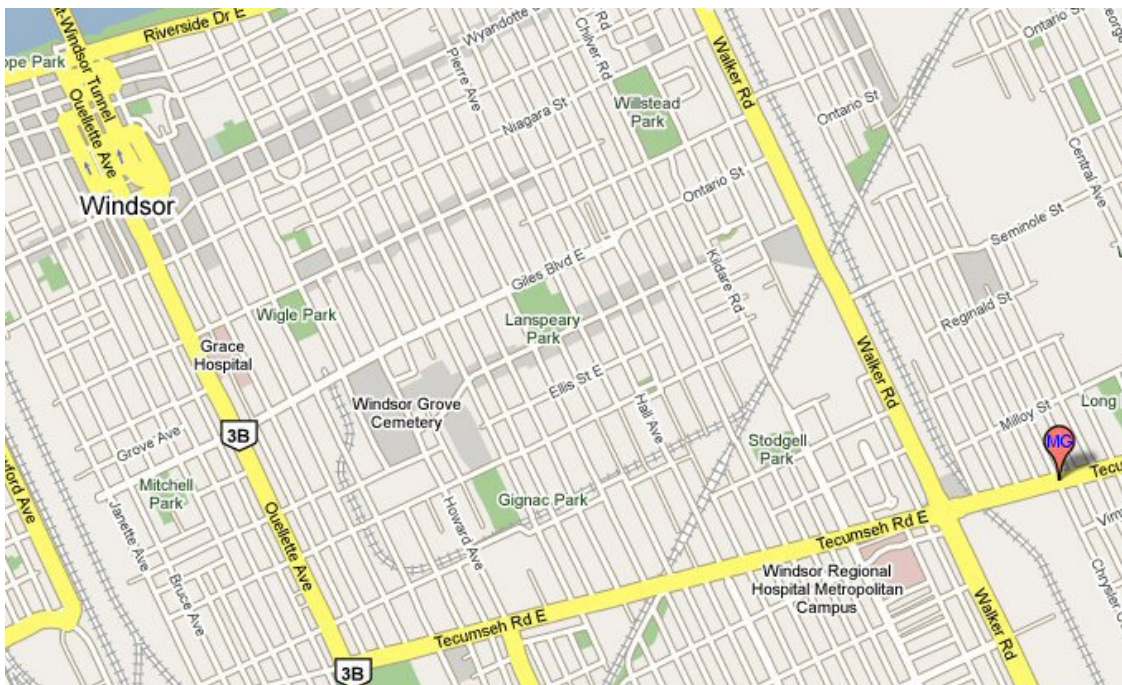

On exiting Canada Customs, turn immediately left onto Park Street (one way).
After 150 ft (50m) at the light, turn left onto Ouellette Ave.
Travel 1.5 miles (2.4km) and turn left onto Tecumseh Rd. E.
Travel 1.9 miles (3km) and the Windsor Family Credit Union will be found on the left at the junction of Tecumseh Rd. E. and Drouillard Rd.
