


Meet at 10:00 am in Belleville.

We'll meet at the Burger King on Rawsonville Rd, Belleville, ¼-mile (0.4km) south of the junction with I-94, which is about 12-miles (19km) west of Metro Airport. **Try to arrive at 10:00 am for a drivers' and navigators' meeting and a 10:30 am get away.** For those who arrive early there are gas stations, several other restaurants (including a Tim Horton's that we've had especially built so Canadian members can feel at home) and a K-Mart across the street.
