



During CBA 41, in Petersburg, Virginia, we joined hands and hearts in solemn admiration of these beautiful stained-glass windows in the Blandford Church, circa 1735, which were crafted by Louis Comfort Tiffany (1848-1933), between 1904 and 1912. Each of the large windows contains the image of a Saint and symbols associated with the Saint. Most display a state seal in recognition of the states from which the soldiers came to battle there during the Civil War. The four smaller windows were designed to compliment the larger ones. In addition, there is a window of a Christian cross of jewels donated by Louis Comfort Tiffany. The church and cemetery have a remarkable story.
