 9:00am-5:00pm, 7 days, FREE World's largest and oldest military aviation museum. Over 360 aircraft on display in 19 acres of space under roof. Located on Wright-Patterson AFB Approximately 8 miles to our hotel
2. Carillon Historical Park
 ...1000 Carillon Blvd, Dayton, OH
 9:30am-5:00pm Mon-Sat, \$14, \$12 seniors
 65 acre open air campus of historic buildings and displays of items connected to Dayton's wealth of manufacturing, automotive, transportation and aviation history. 2 miles from the hotel.
3. America's Packard Museum
 ...420 S Ludlow St, Dayton, OH 12:00pm-5:00pm Wed-Sat, \$15, \$10 seniors Some 50 Packard vehicles and automobilia on display housed at Citizen's Motorcar Company, in an original Packard dealership bldg. Approximately 2.5 miles to the hotel
4. Dayton Aviation Heritage National Park –
 ...Wright Cycle Company Complex
 16 S Williams Street, Dayton, OH
 9:00am-4:00pm 7 days, FREE The building was home to the Wright's bicycle business in the 1890s, preceding their work on the development of powered flight. Approximately 2.7 miles from the hotel

5. John W Berry Wright Brothers National Museum ...Located within Carillon Historical Park, (see above for hours and fees) Designed by Orville Wright specifically for the display and preservation of the 1905 Wright Flyer III airplane Adjacent to a replica of the Wright brothers' final bicycle shop. The original shop was purchased by Henry Ford and moved to Greenfield Village in Dearborn, MI in the 1930's.
6. Riverscape Metropark – Five Rivers
 ...Fountain of Lights
 237 E Monument Avenue, Dayton, OH Site of one of the world's largest fountains. Water shoots 200 feet high and 400 feet across the river from five towers to a central spray located at the confluence of the Mad and Great Miami rivers. The fountain operates 5 minutes before to 5 minutes after the hour, each hour. Approximately 3 miles from the hotel.
7. British Transportation Museum
 ...321 Hopeland Street, Dayton, OH
 Volunteer operated British car museum with 40+ British cars and 15 bicycles in the museum's collection plus various cars on loan. Saturday & Monday 10am-4pm (other hours can be arranged on request in advance) Approximately 1 mile to the hotel
