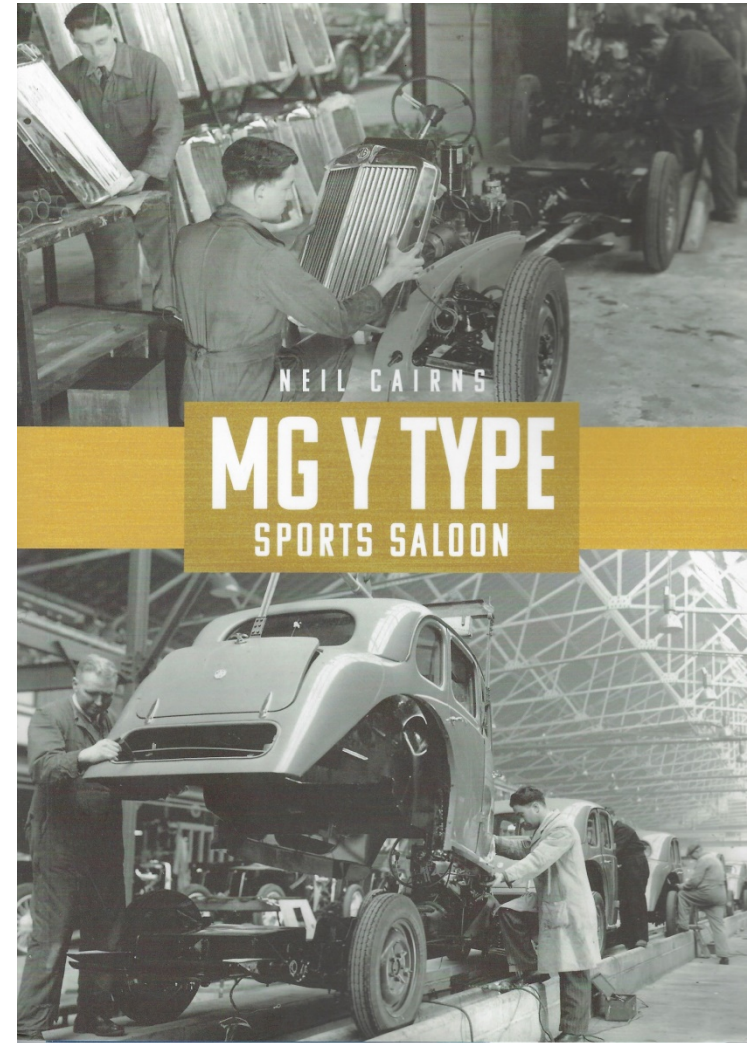
This event is organised by the Australian M.G. Y-Type Register as a member of the International M.G. Y-Type Register.

Driving Etiquette

On events such as this, it is vitally important to the cause of the Classic Car Movement that we behave and drive with respect to all road users.

Remember that what we do is a privilege, and most people do not appreciate old cars, but we are blessed, and we are not ignorant.

To this end I would just like to refresh a few simple rules to ensure we do our best to promote ourselves to the greater motoring community.

- Limit ‘convoys’ to no more than THREE cars.
- Allow space between cars so others may safely overtake.
- Pull over and let faster traffic pass – no moving road blocks !
- **If you do stop and require help, raise your arm in the air.**
- If you see another Y stopped and there is no arm raised – drive on and do not add to the car park.
- When parking, allow room for opening doors and photos!
- Talk to those people who show an interest in your car.
- We have a timetable of places to visit and meals to eat – don’t dawdle, do concentrate on the driving – but don’t be early !.
- If you are not comfortable with navigation instructions, just ask someone if you can follow them – but keep a safe distance – no one likes tailgaters.
- If you arrive at a lookout and the car park is full, please drive on, find a safe place to U-Turn and park where it is safe.

Then it is farewell until 2027 & the 80 year celebration!

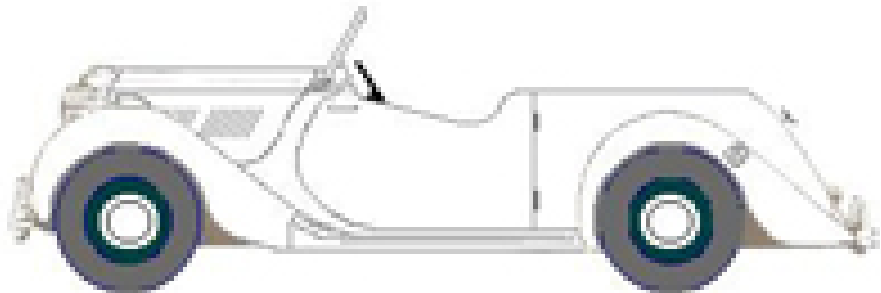
