# MG YA £9950



MG DIDN'T BUILD only sports cars — its saloons have a charm all of their own. The Y-type was designed in the Thirties, but production was delayed until 1947. It had independent front suspension — an advanced feature then — and

rack-and-pinion steering. The pressed steel body was a departure from MG's old timberframed construction, but a traditional interior kept the links with the past.

Step into this pretty YA and savour its pristine interior: the polished wood dashboard with its octagonal dials, the beige seats piped in chocolate-brown, and a plush, dark brown carpet. Then look out and anticipate the view along the bonnet between those headlamps, framed by the timber-edged windscreen. Feel the chromed window winders and door handles, put your hands on that big wire-spoked steering wheel, and get ready to drive Forties-style.

This same 1250cc engine was fitted in contemporary Midgets and pulls the car along with rowdy enthusiasm. The gearbox, with synchromesh on second, third and top, is a period piece of engineering which is easy to get used to, but the brakes need early and firm pressure – don't underestimate how much bringing cars to a halt has evolved since 1948.

Overall, a pleasing blend of MG sport with saloon grace. Eric Kwiatkowski

# CHECKLIST

## **Originality**

Extensively restored inside and out, with photographic record.

#### Maintenance and history

Comes with original log book plus bills for body-off restoration – £6000 for parts alone, including new clutch, carpets and exhaust.

#### **Bodywork and structure**

Panel fit good, doors shut well. Body and chassis look solid underneath and are painted with no underseal applied.

### **Exterior fittings**

Generally very good apart from a little headlamp rim corrosion.

## Engine

Starts promptly with no smoke, leaks or knocking. Oil pressure constant at 50psi.

# Transmission

Changes are clean and crisp.

#### Interior

Beautifully presented with the dashboard polished to a muted sheen rather than a brash gloss. Seats and headlining renewed.

All the work has been done – it's ready to enjoy at an attractive price.
