4-door sports saloon. F/R, 1250cc (\$4
OHV). Would have been 1941's new MG and looks it, with its Morris 8 body panels.
cramped body and close-set pedals that won't fit feet over size 10. Chassis is a longer TD with same suspension steering. YBs have 2LS brakes and hypoid rear axles. Charming, but runs out of steam at 70mph.



YT. 1948-50 (prod: 877). 4-seater tourer. F/R, 1250cc (S4 OHV). Hybrid YA/TD, with former's chassis and latter's engine, plus somewhat ponderous 1938-style tourer bodywork. Not a great success and export-only, but a good few went to Commonwealth countries, ergo rhd is likely. A surprising number still around in Britain.
