





The new Wessex caravan is low built when in travelling trim. When parked, the roof rises on hinges to give head room, and a canopy tent can be added making room for two camp beds.

THE tendency towards caravans that are true touring models and can be easily towed is followed by the new Wessex model. It has a floor size of 9ft by 5ft, and is low built, the roof hingeing up to provide 6ft 6in headroom at the rear of the van. There are two sprung mattresses, and an end kitchen with a stove and cupboards. The price, exclusive of the canopy extension, shown above, is £195 ex-works.

The body is of hardboard panels on a timber frame, and the chassis is all-steel; the specification includes 4.00 × 16in tyres, half-elliptic springs, overrun brakes, and a telescopic jack at each corner. The weight is approximately 6½ cwt.

The makers are Wessex Industries (Poole), Ltd., and the distributors are Montrose Caravan Distributors, Ltd., Stockport Road, Cheadle, Cheshire.
