


## The Classic 'Y'

## Car for Sale

In the process of looking around for a Y-Type to buy late last year, Don Fry came across one in Southport which was for sale. This is what he has told me of it...

"The Southport car is actually in a k. The owner is Ken Williams on a farm-type property by the level-crossing. It is white and was restored some time ago, but not completed. The engine runs but it is impossible to get the car out of its present position. I decided that I would wait until I found a better one.

This car was included in an article by the motoring writer Michael Worthington-Williams in the Classic Car Mart in September 2006. Ken had bought a 1926 Austin 20 off him: he already had two in pieces! The place is full of wonderful old cars, Rolls-Royces, a Graham Page, Vulcan, Invicta, etc."

My new "YA" is Y/6409, Reg. "UMG215", and it's a really nice one. The V5c states only five previous owners, so I thought I would try to trace its history as far back as possible. Referring to the paperwork which came with it, I have written to several names on various bills. The one I really wanted to hear from was the man who had done the restoration. His name is Sam Crutchley (no relation to the Octagon Club's Harry Crutchley).

I was surprised when I received a call from Sam Crutchley, and he told me all he could. I now get to the interesting bit... Guess where he found it - yes, another one from Southport, where it had been locked away since 1973. Someone in M.G. circles had heard that it was for sale and told Sam, so he went to see it, bought it, and trailered it back to his home in Lichfield. This was in 1991 or '92. It was red/maroon then but is now two-tone green.

I hope you can stand all this excitement, John, as I have another story about Southport. One Saturday evening in the early '60s, my wife and I had a run to Southport in my then red "YA" "KVM358". As we turned off Lord Street to park, there were two identical red "YA"s parked there, so I parked behind them. To see what even by then were three elderly cars, all identical, was quite a sight. When we returned the other two had gone and I have often wondered what their owners thought on seeing mine. Perhaps one of them was my new one; we'll never know. What a shame no-one left a note.

With my apologies for the boring story, John, but this car is reliving all my "YA" memories.
