This time we can start with three group photos, courtesy of Dave Lawrence in South Africa. At the top of p.2 is a line-up taken at the M.G. Show Day in Pretoria, South Africa on 11th June 2003. And then the second group (of 13 saloons and one Y/T) was photographed in the town of Luxembourg for the Y-Type 50th Anniversary celebrations which took place between 25th August and 1st September in 1997. Ten years later, the larger photo at the top of p.3 shows the 60th Anniversary Meeting, at Maitland, N.S.W., Australia (April 2007). The original (in colour) of this last-mentioned photo reveals a very varied array of exterior colours on the cars in the group. Admittedly, very few of the cars seem to be finished in colours which were available from the factory when they were new, but two-tone cream/maroon, red/gold, cream/black, maroon/black combinations and several different attempts at two-tone green, plus all-over grey (two distinct shades) made for a very pleasing and eye-catching spectacle.

The lower of the photos on p.3 and the large picture which occupies all of p.4 are of YB/1041, mentioned in TCY 198 and now owned by Ed Winters. Ed is a professional photographer and took these photos of his cream (Old English White or Ivory?) car.
