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EDITORIAL

This month's editorial looks like it's going to end up a good deal longer than usual because, perhaps surprisingly after twelve years, news continues to flood in to me from around the world about 'Y' Types we have not heard of before. And the number of active Register members has scarcely ever been higher. Several members have written to me to keep me up to date on how their restorations are coming. Eric Peacock from Tollesbury, Essex is busy building one good YB out of the best part of five 'Y' Types! He has various spare chassis, engines and many other surplus parts to dispose of. David Mullen has full details of these if any of you wish to purchase anything and brief details of the chassis are to be found on the last page of this newsletter under 'Cars for Sale'.

Rocky von Dullen and Mike Lewis who come from the New Orleans area have a YB and YA respectively. Rocky writes... "the chassis/powertrain is finished. Only the rusty body remains! I am going to put dual 1½" S.U.s with a TD/TF intake/exhaust system on the car. I've also kept all the original carb/intake/exhaust system. Mike and I put an AEG122 equivalent camshaft and big valves in the engine during rebuild so it's best to 'let it breath' better than the single S.U. would allow. It's .060" overbore (1310cc). I guess it's good for 60bhp. I'm also investigating a set of TF hubs and brake drums for wire wheels. Mike has such a set for his TF now, so we may try his on the YB first to see how it looks - I'd guess it will resemble a VA. Do you know of any source for detailed drawings of body and trim parts? Neither the Workshop Manual nor the Parts Lists shows these." This last point is something that was highlighted by another of our members recently. We have never really had a good comprehensive article on interior re-trimming etc as relating particularly to 'Y' Types? Can anyone help?

You may recall that in our August issue we had a photo of Lesley Hodgson's 'YA' in Denmark. Well, not long after the Hodgson family returned from a trouble-free run around Denmark, the 'YA' was involved in crash which tore one of its front wheels off and left it on its side. Fortunately, Mrs. Hodgson and her eight-year-old were able to escape through the sunroof with nothing more serious than bruises. The 'YA' is going to be rebuilt.


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Talking of Denmark, more left-hand-drive 'YA's have turned up; four in Denmark and another in the Netherlands. Bjarne Berner from Glamsbjerg, Denmark sent me photos of his two-tone maroon and black example and one of these photos might find its way into the newsletter in due course. That makes around ten LHD 'YA's in all, I think, worldwide. Mel Fry, our Australian contact, would like to know whether anyone can tell him the reason for the small hole in the top of the differential housing on some YTs/'YA's. He says... "it is not threaded and is approximately 11/64" in diameter. The hole is 160mm from the centre of the differential housing on the drivers' side (RHD car). Could it be a breather?"

In this issue of 'The Classic Y', you'll find a listing of books etc I have for sale; something different for the Christmas period, perhaps. These are items I've accumulated over the last twelve years or so and I thought that it was about time I passed them on to interested members so that they might learn as much from them as I have.

Some of you may have heard that the New England M.G. 'T' Register (in the U.S.A.) are planning a trip to the U.K. for their members next summer. The plan is to ship a hundred or so 'T' and 'Y' Types over and then drive them around Britain to what looks like quite a gruelling schedule between 3rd and 23rd July. The route is to be: Liverpool - Bath - Penzance - Exeter - Beaulieu - Abingdon (for almost a week's stay) - York - Edinburgh - Inverness - Glasgow - Lake District - Liverpool. There could be half-a-dozen or so 'Y' Types coming, maybe more....

And last, but certainly by no means least, a good friend of mine, Mr. Reg Weeding of Farnborough, Hampshire has offered to check over members cars for them. He says... "should any member like any checks done on his/her car and care to call at my address below, I will be only too pleased to accommodate and talk cars and, who knows, maybe supply a cup of tea or coffee. 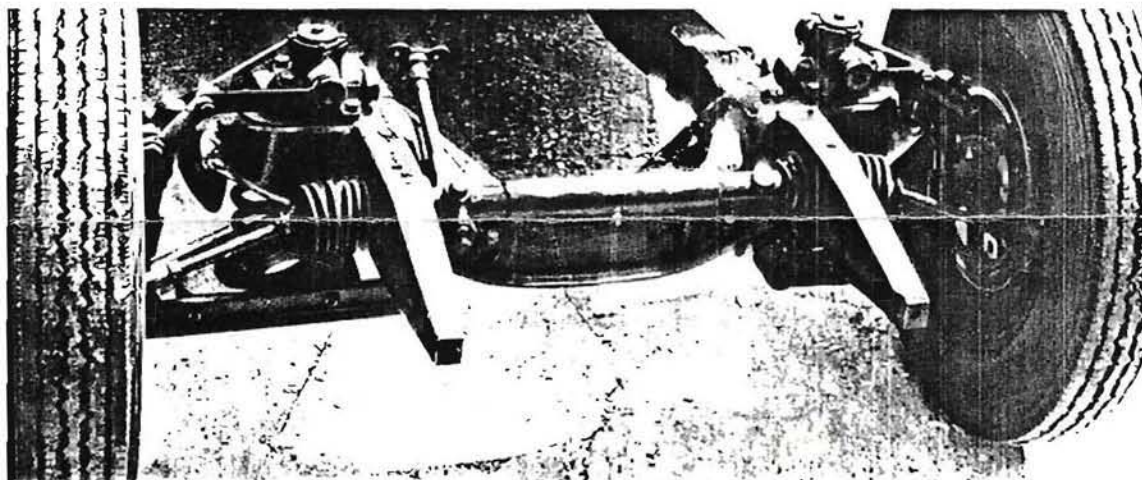
