The Rear Window Blind

(We often get requests to explain what goes to make up this interior fitting on saloons, and what fits where - now, Dave Lawrence provides all the answers)

Details of Roller Blind Assembly from Parts Lists

"YA"/YB (both the same)	B281/	
Blind material (stitched)	1 236 Roller barrel with end brackets	1
Oval strip	1 253 Blind cord	1
Control knob	1 255 Control ring	1
Pulley	1 272 Pulley	1
Screw eyes	5	


For the "YA", parts numbers are all B281/... The YB has different parts numbers (in a new B.M.C. system).

Notes:


- 1. The oval strip is just a piece of wood.
- The control ring is a cream coloured Bakelite ring for pulling th blind up.
- 3. The control knob is a small cream coloured Bakelite ball fixed over a screw. It is screwed into the side of the car, above the driver's door, and the control ring hooks over it, to retain the blind in the "up" position.
- 4. The two pulleys are of different types (different parts numbers).
- The screw eyes are similar to those available today, but slightly smaller, and of slightly thicker metal.
- 6. There are, of course, two "end brackets", slightly different from each other, and completely separate from the barrel. Why they are not listed separately in the Parts List is not known.





BLIND RETRACTION MECHANISM



METHOD OF OPERATION


- 1 LOCATING LUG FITS INTO END BRACKET, THEREFORE HELD STATIONARY
- 2) OTHER END OF LOCATING LUG ATTACHED TO WOODEN ROD, THEREFORE ROD IS HELD STATIONARY
- 3 METAL END CAP IS TACKED TO ROLLER BARREL, AND THEREFORE ROTATES
- (4) ONE END OF SPRING IS ATTACHED TO METAL CAP (INSIDE), AND IS FREE
 TO ROTATE AS METAL CAP ROTATES. THE OTHER END OF THE
 SPRING IS HELD IN THE SLOT IN THE WOODEN ROD, WHICH IS NOT
 FREE TO ROTATE
- (5) WHEN THE BLIND CORD IS PULLED, THIS ROTATES THE ROLLER BARREL, AND THEREFORE THE METAL CAP AND ONE END OF THE SPRING. AS THE OTHER END OF THE SPRING CANNOT ROTATE, THE SPRING IS TENSIONED, ALLOWING RETRACTION OF THE BLIND WHEN THE CORD IS RELEASED.

NOTE S

1) THE TWO BRACKETS ARE IDENTICAL, EXCEPT FOR THE LOCATING HOLES FOR THE LUGS ON THE ROLLER BARREL


PULLEY ASSEMBLIES

- THE SAME AS OPIGINALLY, BUT WOUD BE VERY CLOSE! THIS MAY OF MAY NOT BE 1 THE PUSITIONING OF THE SCREW EYES IS AS PER MY
- 3) THE PULLEY PUSITIONS ARE AS ORIGINALLY.
- THE INTERIOR LIGHT SWITCH SLIGHTLY FURTHER POSITIONED SLIGHTLY FURTHER FURWARD, (AND 3) IN THE PICTURE BELOW, THE CONTROL RING IS BACK,), THAN ON MY "YB"
