

MG Car Club Lincolnshire Centre Invitation Autotest Sunday 13th May 2007 Additional Supplementary Regulations

- 1. The Lincolnshire Centre of the MG Car Club will promote a closed permit promotional Autotest on Sunday 13th May 2007 at East Kirkby Airfield.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Competition Rules, Standing Supplementary Regulations of the M.S.A. Ltd incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., these A.S.R.'s and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
- 3. An M.S.A. Permit has been applied for.
- 4. The event is open to: all fully elected members of the promoting club and invited guests. *Club membership cards will be inspected at signing on*, but competition licences are not required.
- 5. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:-Scrutineering starts at 10am. First Test 11am. Any competitor not signed on by 10.45 am will be excluded.
- 6. The event will consist of four classes as follows:-
 - (1) Sports Cars
 (2) Saloon Cars
 (3) Vintage, P.V.T. and MG MMM & T Register Cars
 (4) Ladies
 All vehicles must comply with the M.S.A. Technical Regulations
- 7. Awards will be presented as follows:A. BTD An award
 B. Positions gained by competitors will be used in determining points scored towards the Annual Trophies for classes 1 to 4 and
 C. First L.W.B. Sports Car [over 84" wheelbase] The Bush Trophy [Annual] and
 D. First Novice An Award [Annual]
 All Awards will be presented at the Lincolnshing Cantre Annual Dipper & Dance on Saturday 19th
 - All Awards will be presented at the Lincolnshire Centre Annual Dinner & Dance on Saturday 19th Janaury 2008.
- 8. The maximum number of entries per class is 20. The minimum for each class is 3. The maximum number for the meeting including reserves is 40. The minimum is 12. Should any of the minimum figures above not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as required.
- 9. The entry list opens on 1st March 2007 and <u>closes finally on 8th May 2007</u>. The entry fee is £11.
 All entries must be made on official entry forms and accompanied by the appropriate fee. All cheques/POs should be made payable to the 'MG Car Club Lincolnshire Centre'.

- 12. Provisional Results will be published as soon as possible after the event. Protests must be made in accordance with G.R. 051.
- 13. [a] Details of the tests will be circulated.
 - [b] Practising will <u>not</u> be allowed.
 - [c] Each driver will have one run at each test to count for an award.
 - [d] Cars will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers attached to the car.
 - [e] Timing will be by Stopwatch.
 - [f] The starting signal will be verbal.
 - [g] Timing will start when competitor's front wheels cross the start line.
 - [h] Order of attempting tests will be in numerical order.
- All other S.S.R.s of the M.S.A. apply as written except for the following which are modified:-F.4.3.2. Pylons shall be fluorescent marker cones approximately 2'6" in height of non damaging rubber material
- 15. The site of the tests is located within the Aviation Heritage Centre on East Kirkby Airfield. Access to be gained from the A155 via the crossroads near Hagnaby Priory by taking the unclassified road South for about 300 yards, following the Castrol Arrows to the entrance to the paddock area.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ENTER through the Main Entrance to the Aviation Heritage Centre. Please drive <u>slowly</u> and carefully within the site at all times.
