

# MG Car Club Lincolnshire Centre Jubilee Rallye 2018

## Instructions

1. This is a test of navigational skills. Use of GPS systems, phone Apps or any similar navigational aid is prohibited and will result in exclusion.
2. Odometer readings will be taken at the start and finish of the rally to assist the Judges in determining the lowest mileage.
3. One point will be allocated per correctly identified clue and answer. The judges may award a ½ point if, in their opinion, the answer is nearly correct.
4. There is a total of 26 points to be plotted.
5. You must visit 18 of these points.
6. **Points 1, 3, 13, 21 & 25 are compulsory.**
7. Ten points will be deducted if a mandatory clue has not been visited
8. Competitors with the lowest mileage and the highest score will win the Jubilee trophy which will be presented at the MGCC Lincolnshire Annual Awards Dinner in January 2018.
9. The novice team (i.e. a team who have never won either the Jubilee or Holland Brothers Trophy) will win the Muncaster Trophy which will be presented at the MGCC Lincolnshire Annual Awards Dinner in February 2019
10. Please drive at all times in a courteous and respectful manner.
11. Please note that the answers to most clues may not be seen from the driver or passenger seats.

All cars should be on their way by 10.15, at the latest, in order to arrive at the finish in time for those that wish to take lunch and / or a tour. Cars arriving at the finish after 1.45pm will not be included in the results.

After completing the required number of points, proceed to the finish at the International Bomber Command Centre, Canwick Hill, Lincoln LN4 2HQ (Map 121 Grid Ref 986 694). where there will be a special parking area in front of the main building for all participants. Snacks & light lunches will be available, as will guided tours (free) for those who would like to do it.

If you do not have Map 121 with you, head onto the A15 northbound, go through Bracebridge Heath and take right turn at the traffic lights onto the B1131 following the signs to the IBCC.
