SATURDAY 10th SEPTEMBER 2005 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- The M.G. Car Club (South West) Centre will organise a National B Status Speed Hill Climb on Saturday 10th September 2005 at Wiscombe Park, Honiton, Devon.
- The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the 2. provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that theorganising club may issue for the event.
- M.S.A. Permit Number 30744
- The event is open to:
 - (a) All fully elected members of the MG Car Club
 - (b) Members of the Woolbridge Motor Club, Triumph TR Register, Westfield Sports Car Club, Reliant Scimitar & Sabre Owners Club Ltd, Lotus Seven Club, and Volvo Owners Club.
- All Competitors and drivers must produce a valid competition licence and Club Membership Card.
- The event is a round of the MGCC SW Championship, Luffield Speed Championship, TR Register Championship, 6. R.S.S. Sprint & Hill Climb Championship, Westfield S.C.C. Speed Championship & Lotus 7 Speed Championship.
- The programme of the meeting will be: Scrutineering starts at 8.15 a.m. Practising Starts at 9.15 a.m. First Timed Run 1.00 p.m.

Individual times for scrutineering will not be notified. Any competitor not signed on by 10.00 a.m. may be excluded.

- The length of the course is 900m (1000yds) and consists of one sharp left hander at the start, a sweeping g radient leading to several fast bends which end with a RH hairpin leading onto a straight, ending with a LH hairpin with the finish just beyond. The average gradient is 1 in 13.6 and the steepest part is 1 in 6.9. The surface is sealed tarmacadam.
- Theevent will consist of 15 classes as follows:
 - Class 1 Vintage cars, sports saloons and touring cars pre 1931
 - Class 2 (a) Un-supercharged sports or saloon M.G. cars accepted by the MMM Register, 2 or 4 seaters.
 - (b) Supercharged sports or saloon M.G. cars accepted by the MMM Register, 2 or 4 seater.

MMM cars must be fitted with wings and lights and be suitable for road use. Cars not so fitted may be placed in Class 3 (d) or Class 11.

 - (c) M.G. T type cars- modified (as defined by the T Register).

 - (d) 1601c.c. and over

The organisers reserve the right to transfer a car out of the class in which it was entered if it is deemed necessary by the organisers in the spirit of these regulations.

The organisers' decisions on classification shall be final and the right is reserved to sub-divide or amalgamate classes at their discretion.

All vehicles must comply with M.S.A. Technical Regulations.

- Awards will be presented as follows:
 - 1. There will be an award to the winner of each class or sub-divided class, a second in class award if there are at least 6 cars in the class and a third in class award, if there are at least 12 cars in the class or sub-divided class.
 - 2. The Cider Apple Trophy will be awarded for the best time by an M.G T-type, The Don Smith Trophy for the best time by a M.M.M. car and the **Bristol Motor Company Cup** to the best performance by an M.G.C.C. member driving an M.G. car. These trophies are returnable after a period of eleven months. Winners of these awards will also receive the appropriate perpetual award. No competitor may receive more than one award.
- The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes finally on **Thurs 1**st **September**. The entry fee is £67.

All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.

The maximum entry for the meeting including reserves is 150. The minimum is 60. The minimum for each class is 4. Should any of the above minimum numbers not be reached, then the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected strictly in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded:

In the event of cancellation the sum of £10 will be deducted from each entry for administration expenses.

- Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each class has completed its run.
- Any protest must be lodged in accordance with O5.
- Cars will be directed to and positioned on the start line by the Start line official. Cars will start singly from a standing start with the car cutting a light beam at the start and will end by the car cutting a similar beam at the finish. The finish will be indicated by a banner over the finish line. Timing struts must be fitted in accordance with the L10, 9.1
- Practice: Competitors will have the opportunity of two runs after walking the course under official control.
- Competitors will be identified by numbers which will not be provided by the organisers (see L9. 2.5.)
- Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the M.S.A. Regulations.
- All other general regulation of the M.S.A. apply as written except for the following which are modified. L9. 2.3. No driver may drive more than one car in any class of more than 2 cars in the whole competition. No car may be driven by more than two drivers. L9.5.1. Each driver shall be given a minimum of two runs in the same car in each class entered. the faster run to count for the results.
- The organisers reserve the right to restrict each driver to one entry only depending on the number of double entries received.
- A red flag means complete and immediate stop.

All other information will be sent to you in the "Final Instructions" during the week before the event.
