- 1. The MG Car Club (South West Centre) and the Bristol Pegasus Motor Club will organise a Clubsport Autotest on 24-9-06 at the Rolls-Royce main car park, Gypsy Patch Lane (B4057), Patchway, Bristol.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulation of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provision of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising clubs may issue for the event.
- 3. MSA Permit number has been applied for.
- 4. The event is only open to fully elected members of the organising clubs and Bristol Motor Club.
- 5. All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership Card. A Competition Licence is NOT required.
- 6. The event is a round of the MG Car Club South West Centres Clubman Championship.
- 7. The programme of the meeting will be: Scrutineering starts at: 9.30 am

Tests start at: 10.15 am

Any competitor not signed on by 9.45 may be excluded.

Depending on numbers entered, it is anticipated the event will finish by around 2 pm

8. The event will consist of the classes listed below. With the exception of MG saloons manufactured after the MG ZB, classes A to F are for non MGs:

Class A Mid-engined, rear-engined and front-wheel-drive cars 12ft long and shorter.

Class B As 'A' but over 12ft long.

Class C Front-engined rear-wheel-drive saloons 12ft long and shorter

Class D As 'C' but over 12ft long

Class E Open and sports cars 12ft long and shorter.

Class F As 'E' but over 12ft long

Class G MG Midgets and Austin Healey Sprites

Class H MGBs, MGCs, MGB V8s

Class I Type MGs

Class J Vintage and MMM MG sports cars.
Class K MG Saloons (ZBs and earlier)

Class L MGFs

Class M Autotest specials (all car's with limited slip diffs)

The organising clubs reserve the right to amalgamate or sub-divide classes at their discretion.

- All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations and must be fitted with an effective silencer. Cars need not be taxed.
- 10. Awards will be presented as follows:

- 11. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and postal entries close on 22-9-06. Entries will be accepted on the day providing the maximum number of entries has not been reached, this being 25.
- 12. The entry fee is £8.00 in advance and £10.00 on the day. Cheques should be made payable to the MG Car Club (South West Centre).

All marshals will be Judges of Facts in respect to F5.1.

- 14. The minimum advanced entry is 10. Should this figure not be met the organisers have the right to cancel the event. Entries will be **FULLY refunded** if the event has to be cancelled for any reason.
- 15. Details of the tests will be contained in the Final Instructions which will be available at signing on.
- 16. Protests should be made in writing in accordance with Section O, paragraph 5. Each protest must be accompanied by the appropriate fee.
- 17. Provision results will be despatched by post within 7 days of the event.
- 18. The event will consist of a minimum of 4 tests, each being attempted at least twice. The worst score for each test will not be included in the results.
- 19. The organisers will provide numbers for identifying cars, if deemed necessary.
- 20. Timing will be hand held stop watches to 0.1 second. Competitors will start in their own time following a signal from the marshal.
- 21. A car may be driven by a second competitor.
- 22. The General Regulations of the MSA apply except:
 - F3.1.4 Posts or pylons may be less than 1 metre in height.
- 23. Practising will NOT be allowed.
- 24. Marking and penalties will be as listed in section F10.2 of the MSA General Regulation, except as modified below:

Performing a test incorrectly other than in 'd' or 'e' of table 1 (e.g. striking any barrier or failing to cross or stop at a line):

10 marks plus the highest penalty incurred by any competitor in the class making a correct attempt on that test.
