## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. The MG Car Club (South West Centre) will organise a Navigational Scatter event on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2007.
- 2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations. The permit has been applied for.
- 3. The event will be run using the 1:50,000 series Ordnance Survey map, Landranger 162 Gloucester and Forest of Dean. A recent version of this map, a pencil for marking points on the map and filling in answers to the questions, and your Club Membership Card will be all that is required. A 'romer' (simple device for precise location of grid references) shall be useful; romers can be supplied at cost (approximately £1) providing that the organiser is given at least two weeks notice.
- 4. The event will start from a location to be advised in the Final Instructions, in the vicinity of Wotton-under-Edge. Signing-on will start at 9:45am and any competitor not signed on by 10:15am may be deemed a non-starter and his/her entry replaced by a reserve. Participants will start at 10:30am.
- 5. The event will finish at a location to be advised in the final instructions. It is proving ever more difficult to identify an establishment with sufficient space to accommodate an unknown number of competitors for Sunday lunch. Therefore, the event will NOT be finishing at a pub: ie no food will be available.
- 6. Participants will be required to visit a selection of points defined by grid references and at each point answer a question related thereto. The list of points will be handed out at 10:30am. Participants will not be required to visit more than 75% of the points; the maximum number of answers to count towards the final score will be specified in the Final Instructions Total distance will be approximately 50 miles. Please note that:
  - reduced points will be awarded for partially correct answers, and
  - penalty points may be deducted for late arrival at the finish at the discretion of the organisers.

MSA rules require significant Public Relations (PR) activity in respect of this type of event, particularly for residences within 500m of any point where a vehicle is required to stop. In view of the effort required to identify suitable locations or undertake PR work, you should please note that the event will be based on the maps and locations used in the Autumn Naviscat 2002.

- 7. Classes will be as follows (the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes as necessary):
  - A Really old: Vintage, MMM, S, V, W
  - B Quite old: T, Y and Z-Types
  - C Old, Midgets & Sprites, MGA/B/C/RV8
  - D Modern, MGF, 1980s FWD, new Zs, etc
  - E Novice older cars (split to be determined prior to start of event)
  - F Novice newer cars (split to be determined prior to start of event)
- 8. Awards will be as follows:
  - 1 First MG (if not covered by the above)
  - 2 First in class (subject to 3 entries in class)
  - 3 Second in class (subject to 6 entries in class)
- 9. The entry fee of £10 per car should be enclosed with the entry. Cheques should be payable to 'MG Car Club South West Centre'. Entries may be accepted on the day, when the entry fee shall be £12, again payable by cheque please. The mimimum number of entrants is 12 and the maximum 30. The event will proceed only if the minimum number of entries is received by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March.
