Saturday, May 17, 2008

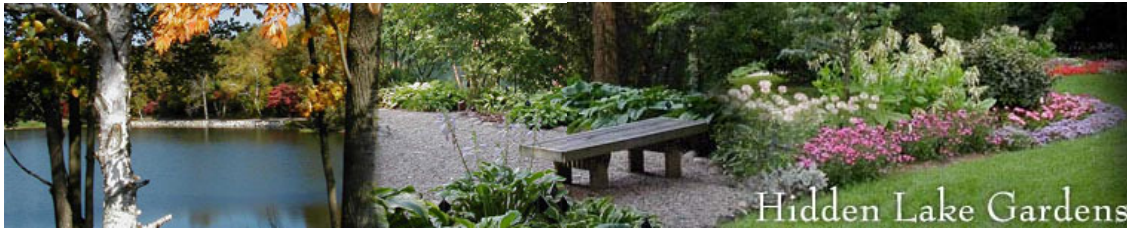

We have planned a multi club British Car Tour to Hidden Lake Gardens, located in Tipton, MI. This 775-acre facility is operated by Michigan State University since its inception in 1945. It has 120-acre arboretum, a hosta hillside garden and a conservatory. One of its delights is a 4-mile drive through the woods on a single-lane winding road.

Our hosts and fellow MG-T Club members Bob and Eleanor Lorentz will guide us to, and through the gardens.

As a side trip we will be visiting the restoration facility of Bob Anzalone. He is a well-known restorer of many winning Concours automobiles. We will spend about 1 hour on the site, which is located "out in the country", between Manchester and Brooklyn, MI.

The tour will start at the M-Dot parking facility located at the intersection of I-94 and M-52 in Chelsea, MI. Plan to arrive between 9:30-10:00 am. Various clubs can car pool from their usual jump-off sites and head for Chelsea. Trip maps and instructions will be made available before we leave.

We plan to leave for the Anzalone's at 10:00 am, which is about a 30-minute drive.

From there we will drive to the Golden Nugget for lunch at around noon. The trip to the gardens is only a few minutes away. Plan at least 2+ hours to visit all of the attractions.

Admission to the gardens is \$3.00 per person.
